Canada's New Not-For-Profit Act!

All not-for-profit corporations that were incorporated under the
Canada Corporations Acts (this includes CANNT) are required
to apply for a certificate of continuance to transition to the
Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act before October 17,
2014. This means that before October 17, 2014, corporations
must create, approve and file Articles of Continuance, as well as
by-laws that are compliant with the provisions of the new Act.
Some positive features about the new act include more
comprehensive and flexible by-laws; expands on the rights of
members; provides more clarity around standard of care for
directors, and gives procedural detail.

In preparation for this change, CANNT created a working
group in the summer of 2012. The working group consisted of
Linda Ballantine, Marsha Wood and me, Patty Quinan. Over the
past year, in collaboration with the CANNT board of directors
and Richard Bridge, a lawyer with vast experience in not-for
