Dear Renal Community,

This month's topic, which is near and dear to everyone's heart, is physical space. Whether you are working in an older unit in need of renovating or have the luxury of purpose built designed space, there never seems to be enough physical space! Recently, I have had the good fortune to speak with staff across the country who have recently occupied a new unit, either renovated, refurbished or new build. If your unit is contemplating a physical makeover in the near future, here are the top 10 themes for renal I am hearing:

- 1. There is no such thing as too much space to store equipment.
- 2. Having said this, make sure alcoves for storage can fit a bed if needed.
- 3. Plumb every space possible including conference rooms which can be used in emergencies but also for training.
- 4. In ground scales which can print results and be modified for wheelchair or stretcher/bed are worth their weight in gold.
- 5. Sliders are replacing curtains in popularity due to infection control.
- 6. Movable carts to store nursing supplies can double as a workspace.
- 7. Consider making each patient space same handed so all supplies can be found in the same spot easily.
- 8. Mock up the space before committing if you can to make sure that things like call bells, oxygen, overhead venting and lighting are in the right space.
- 9. Make sure drains in dirty utility rooms can handle the types of solutions being wasted on a renal unit.
- In line K baths are making a comeback. Many European settings have 3 options (K 1, 2 or 3) at each station.
