On the practice front, you may have heard, Amgen the company that makes ARANESP (darbepoetin alfa) in collaboration with health Canada has released a product warning regarding the potential for severe and life threatening skin reactions including Stevens-Johnson (SJS) syndrome and toxic epidermal necrosis (TEN) for patients being treated with this drug. Health care professionals are advised to discontinue therapy immediately if a severe skin reaction occurs or SJS/TENs is suspected and to permanently discontinue treatment if SJS/TENS is confirmed. Health Canada is currently working with the manufacturer to include this information on the Product Safety Monograph. More information can be found here:

From our 2016 CANNT Research Grant Winner, Ann Jones:

Perception of the NP role among healthcare care professionals in hemodialysis

In October 2016, we were the recipients of the research award in London, Ontario at the CANNT conference. The impetus of this award was to fund our proposed study, "Perception of the NP role among healthcare care professionals in hemodialysis." The aim of the study is to explore the perception of the interprofessional (IP) team members with the NP role and to identify any barriers to collaboration with hemodialysis NPs.

Support by CANNT to conduct this study has enabled us the opportunity to explore the research questions. To ensure ethical management of funds allocated for this study, the research award was deposited to a hospital trust account used only for research-related activities. The study is International Society for Peritoneal Dialysis
