

CVS enters home dialysis care with clinical trial of new system

CVS is one of the largest U.S. pharmacy operators and pharmacy benefits managers and also owns Aetna, a top health insurer. It had announced last year that it was working on a home hemodialysis system, which would enable patients with end stage renal disease to have more frequent dialysis and potentially better health outcomes compared with clinic-based care.

'It's a Terrible Existence': The Crisis of Emergency Dialysis Care for Undocumented Immigrants in the United States

About a year and a half ago, Victoria stopped eating. Her face was white. Her legs and stomach were swollen. She couldn't get out of bed. (Victoria is a pseudonym; we're not publishing her real name, because she's an undocumented immigrant.)

Her brother took her to the emergency room, and she was hospitalized immediately. The doctors told her she had diabetes, high blood pressure, and anemia, and her kidneys had failed. "That is, I was very, very sick," Victoria said in an interview, in Spanish.

Victoria is 52 years old; she's originally from Mexico, but she's been living in Texas for more than 30 years. She's a full-time caregiver for her 23-year-old daughter, who was born in the United States and is severely disabled. The two of them live on her daughter's disability checks.
